In the month of February there were a total of **242** complaints generated by the Keith County Communications Center, after removing Traffic Stops. **92** of the complaints, or **38%**, required a written report by an officer. A graph or chart of complaints is included on page 2.

The February Incident Based Reporting shows that the department had **27** reportable **Group A** offenses. The department was able to clear **15** of these offenses for a clearance rate of **56%** for February. We had 4 reports of **Criminal Mischief** for the month, with 0 being cleared for 0%. The department investigated 7 **Theft Offenses** and cleared 3 for a 43% clearance rate. The department investigated 5 **Assault Related Calls** with 4 being cleared for an 80% clearance rate. The department investigated 6 **Narcotics Call** and cleared 6 of them for a clearance rate of 100%. The department investigated 4 **Burglary Calls**. The department investigated and cleared 1 **Sexual Assault** and 1 **Robbery**.


The department either arrested or issued criminal citations in lieu of arrest to **23** individuals in February for **37** criminal offenses. There were 20 adults and 3 juveniles. There were 16 males and 7 females arrested.

IMPOUND: In February, we towed 6 vehicles and released 4.

Total profit to date for 2016 is \$-85.00. Several vehicles still remain in the impound.
