In the month of March there were a total of **299** complaints generated by the Keith County Communications Center, after removing Traffic Stops. **135** of the complaints, or **45%**, required a written report by an officer. A graph or chart of complaints is included on page 2.

The March Incident Based Reporting shows that the department had **45** reportable **Group A** offenses. The department was able to clear **31** of these offenses for a clearance rate of **69%** for March. We had 3 reports of **Criminal Mischief** for the month, with 1 being cleared for 33%. The department investigated 13 **Theft Offenses** and cleared 6 for a 46% clearance rate. The department investigated 8 **Assault Related Calls** with 7 being cleared for an 86% clearance rate. The department investigated 16 **Narcotics Call** and cleared 15 of them for a clearance rate of 94%. The department investigated 4 **Burglary Calls** and cleared 1 for 25%. The department investigated 1 **Sexual Assault**.


The department either arrested or issued criminal citations in lieu of arrest to **33** individuals in March for **47** criminal offenses. There were 27 adults and 6 juveniles. There were 27 males and 6 females arrested.

IMPOUND: In March, we towed 7 vehicles and released 6.

Total profit to date for 2016 is \$85.00. Several vehicles still remain in the impound.
