In the month of May there were a total of **329** complaints generated by the Keith County Communications Center, after removing Traffic Stops. **145** of the complaints, or **44%**, required a written report by an officer. A graph or chart of complaints is included on page 2.

The May Incident Based Reporting shows that the department had **43** reportable **Group A** offenses. The department was able to clear **20** of these offenses for a clearance rate of **47%** for May. We had 5 reports of **Criminal Mischief** for the month, with 0 being cleared for 0%. The department investigated 15 **Theft Offenses** and cleared 4 for a 27% clearance rate. The department investigated 11 **Assault Related Calls** with 5 being cleared for a 45% clearance rate. The department investigated 8 **Narcotics Call** and cleared 8 of them for a clearance rate of 100%. The department investigated 4 **Weapon Crimes** clearing 3 of them.


The department either arrested or issued criminal citations in lieu of arrest to **26** individuals in May for **40** criminal offenses. There were 23 adults and 3 juvenile. There were 17 males and 9 females arrested.

**IMPOUND:** In May, we towed 7 vehicles and released 6.

**Total profit to date for 2016 is \$639.00. Several vehicles still remain in the impound.**
