REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

NOVEMBER 22, 2016

A Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Ogallala, Nebraska, was held at City Hall Council Chambers in said City on the 22th day of November 2016, at 7:00 o'clock P.M. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publishing one time in the Keith County News and posting at the City Hall Administration Building as shown by the Certificate of Publication and Posting Notice attached to these Minutes. Notice of this meeting was simultaneously given to the President and to all members of the Council on November 18, 2016 and a copy of their Acknowledgement of Receipt of Notice and the Agenda is attached to these minutes.
