Interim City Manager addressed the council regarding the specifications for the Cemetery Department Vehicle. With the change in specifications to a regular cab from an extended cab, the cost of such a vehicle does not require an advertised bid process, so no action is necessary on this agenda item.

Mary Wilson, Keith County Area Development presented a quarterly update to the council.

Ken Knoepfel, Planning and Zoning Administrator, addressed the council regarding the proposed ordinance changing the approval process for primary use utility structure and the placement of portable storage pods in the city.

Council President Bassett announced Ordinance 1349 was introduced and read for the first time on November 22, 2016 and for the second time on December 13, 2016. Council President Bassett read Ordinance 1349 by title: An Ordinance Amending Sections 44-1203 - Special Uses, 44-1303 - Special Uses, 44-1403 - Special Uses, 44-302 - Permitted Uses 44-602 - Permitted Uses, 44-802 - Permitted Uses And 44-1002 - Permitted Uses And Adding Sections 44-1712 - Design Standards And 44-1713 - Design Standards Of The Municipal Code Of The City Of Ogallala, Nebraska. Council President Bassett announced that ordinance 1349 has been read for the third time.
