

Request for Proposals

The City of Ogallala is seeking Professional Services to conduct a feasibility study for an interlocal agency Public Transit vehicle maintenance/storage facility to be located in Ogallala, Nebraska. The study will be partially funded by a federal grant under the Section 5311 Program of the Department of Transportation and local funds from individual agencies involved.

The first step in the process will be the submission of a written proposal. Submitted proposals will be reviewed and interviews will be arranged with firms which respond with a written proposal. Please keep the submittals brief and address only those areas outlined on the evaluation form. Upon selection of a firm, a fee will be negotiated. If a suitable fee cannot be negotiated, then negotiations will begin with the next firm in line.

Firms interested in submitting proposals for consideration should submit two copies of a written proposal and an electronic copy by 3:00 p.m. mountain time, Tuesday, July 16, 2013.
