

Policy is for asbestos abatement and certification of asbestos clearance. CGL includes blanket waiver of subrogation, blanket additional insured, broad form property damage, fellow employee liability, unintentional notice of occurrence. Umbrella includes blanket additional insured, fellow employee liability.

Contractor shall assume full responsibility of acts, negligence or omissions of all its employees on the project, for those of its subcontractors and their employees, and for all other persons doing work under a contract with it; and further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Ogallala from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees caused in whole or in part by Contractor, its agents, employees or subcontractors.
