

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids labeled “**Ogallala Control System 2013-1**”, will be received until 2:00 P.M. Mountain Time, on June 6th, 2013 at the City Clerk’s Office, 411 East 2nd, Ogallala, NE at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will not be accepted.

Description of Work: This project shall consist of the following major items or process units:

Contract No. 1: Ogallala Control System 2013-1 – August 2nd, 2013 Completion Date

Water Control System for Public Water system including:
PLC’s
PLC Cabinets
VFD’s with bypass
SCADA Computer and Software
Pressure Transducers
RTD’s

The work shall be started within 30 days of the date of the Notice to Proceed and Contract No. 1 completed by August 2nd, 2013 unless extended due to weather.

Each bidder shall submit, with his Bid, a certified check, Bid Bond, or other equal security instrument in a separate sealed envelope, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of his Base Bid. No Bidder may withdraw his proposal for at least thirty (30) days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of Bids.

A 100 % Performance Bond and the successful Bidder shall furnish Labor & Material Bond within 10 days of the Notice of Award.

Contract documents may be inspected at the office of the Ogallala City Clerk at 411 East 2nd, Ogallala, NE or obtained from the ENGINEER, T.C. ENGINEERING INC.; One South Sycamore; P.O. Box 832; North Platte, Nebraska 69103-0832; (Phone: 308-534-9245) on payment of a non-refundable deposit of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25).

The Owner may require any Bidder to submit to the Engineer, prior to the date of the Bid opening, a properly executed Contractor's Qualification Statement, AIA Document A305, and/or that his Bid be accompanied with a signed certificate from a surety company licensed in the State of Nebraska that the surety company shall provide the Bidder, if awarded the Contract, with a Performance Bond and Labor & Material Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Sum.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive informalities in Bids received. The City reserves the right to accept that bid, with or without alternates, which the City deems most beneficial to the City of Ogallala, Nebraska.

Contract No. 1: Ogallala Control System 2013-1 is a State Revolving Fund (SRF) project and has the additional requirements as listed below:

1. DAVIS BACON ACT WAGE DETERMINATIONS

“Contractors and subcontractors on USEPA federally assisted construction projects are required to pay their laborers and mechanics not less than those established by the U.S. Department of Labor. A current wage decision containing the appropriate building and/or heavy type rates is included in the specifications for bidding purposes.”

2. DEBARMENT AND SUSPENSION

"The prospective participants must certify by submittal of EPA Form 5700-49, Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension and Other Responsibility Matters, that to the best of its knowledge and belief that it and its principals are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any federal department or agency."

3. NONDISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT

"Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246. Requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications."

4. DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE)

"Each bidder must fully comply with the requirements, terms and conditions of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements, including the fair share objectives for disadvantaged business participation during the performance of this contract. The bidder commits itself to the fair share objective for disadvantaged business participation contained herein and all other requirements, terms and conditions of these bid conditions by submitting a properly signed bid."
