Excerpt from Municipal Code

§ 110.015 PLUMBERS AND APPLIANCE DEALERS.

(4) *Application for certificate.* Application for a certificate of qualification or registration shall be made in writing to the Board on standard forms that shall be furnished to the applicants by the City Clerk's office. ('85 Code, § 10-404)

(5) *Bond.* A corporate surety bond in a sum set by the Council and containing such conditions as the City Attorney may specify shall accompany the application, and the written approval of the City Attorney shall be endorsed on the said bond prior to the issuance of a license by the Board. The obligee of the bond shall be the city and action may be maintained thereon by any person injured by a breach of its conditions for a period of one year after the completion of any plumbing work by the applicant. ('85 Code, § 10-405)

(6) *Group coverage.* The license of any plumbing contractor shall be deemed to be sufficient to cover employees of the applicant; provided, that such installation shall be done under the supervision of the licensee. ('85 Code, § 10-406)

(B) *Water softener, water conditioner, and water heater dealers.*

(1) *Licenses and permits.*

(a) All dealers handling water softeners, water conditioners, and water heaters shall have a license to install same. A permit as hereinafter prescribed shall be required for all work done and all work and installation shall be subject to inspection.

(b) If the installation or work done is to replace a prior appliance, no inspection shall be required.

(c) Any such permit shall be limited to the installation of not more than ten feet of water piping and shall not authorize the installation of a sewer drain, waste pipe, or vent line. Such licenses may be granted only upon application and after successful examination by the Board in the manner hereinbefore prescribed for plumbers generally.

(d) Employees of water softener, water conditioner, and water heater dealers shall have a journeyman license. A journeyman license may be granted only upon application and after successful examination by the Board.

(2) *Fees.* The initial fee for a water softener, water conditioner, and water heater dealer's license shall be set by resolution of the Council, a copy of which shall be kept available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk. Thereafter such license may be renewed on or before July 31 by the payment of a fee set by resolution of the Council, a copy of which shall be kept available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk. The initial fee and renewal fee for a journeyman dealer's license shall be set by resolution of the Council, a copy of which shall be kept available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk.
