

Ogallala Board of Health
Meeting
June 18, 2013

Minutes

A meeting of the Ogallala Board of Health was called to order at 7:02 P.M. by Chairman Pete Peterson in the City of Ogallala Administration Building, 411 East Second Street, Ogallala, Nebraska. The meeting was convened in accordance with the Open Meetings Act. Members present: Mary Lou Heelan, Dr. Kurt Johnson, Pete Peterson and Chief of Police Dave Kling. Absent: Dr. Paul Foy. Also present Code Officer Eric Troxel.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance by publication in the Keith County News, the designated method of giving notice. Notice of the meeting was delivered to members of the Board of Health by hand delivery of an Ogallala Police Officer.

Public Forum: Peterson opened the public forum and invited any individual wishing to speak to the board to come to the podium. Peterson advised that the Public Forum would remain open for the duration of the public meeting.

A motion was made by Heelan to approve the minutes of the May 21, 2013 Board of Health Meeting, seconded by Peterson. Voting Yes: Peterson, Heelan, Johnson, and Kling. Voting No: None. Abstain: None. Absent: Foy. Motion carried.

Discussion was held in regards to the Code Enforcement Activity for May to June 2013.

Discussion was held about the Midwest Motel. Kling advised that an owner contacted him on the 17th and said that they would not be able to make this meeting, but would like to speak with area representatives about assistance in cleaning up the property. The owner advised that she had found a video of the property being flooded on YouTube and did not want to invest anything until the drainage issue was solved. The owner also mentioned that they had noticed wet floors in the property many years ago. Kling advised that he would meet with the Ogallala City Attorney and Planning and Zoning Administrator to see what can be done next.

Further discussion was held in regards to Mike's Repair. Kling told Officer Troxel that he had observed Mike Davison's truck in town. Troxel advised that he would try and make contact with Mike Davison.

Lakeside Trailer Court was brought up as all the trailers have been demolished.

No further business to come before the Board, Heelan made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Johnson. Voting Yes: Peterson, Heelan, Johnson, and Kling. Voting No: None. Abstain: None. Absent: Foy. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:22 pm.
